Whole School Student Uniform Policy

Rationale

- To promote the school uniforms keep students focused on their education, not their clothes.
- To create a level playing field among students, reducing peer pressure and bullying.
- To promote the wearing of the school uniforms enhances school pride, unity, and community spirit.
- To promote group identity and equality among students.
- To promote the school name outside of school.
- To encourage respect amongst the staff and students.

Objectives

- To ensure that the whole school is in the correct uniform.
- To inform parents of the correct way to wear the uniform.
- Students should wear their school uniform as a representation of their school pride.
- To develop a sense of belonging in a community.
- To help identify students on trips/outings.
- To encourage students to take pride in their appearance.
- To reflect the school in a positive manner in the wider community.

Responsibilities

1. *Students*

- To ensure the uniform is worn correctly before entering and leaving the school.
- To look presentable throughout the school day.
- To wear the correct uniform during school excursions.
- To ensure that their uniform looks clean and tidy.

2. *Staff*

- To be positive role models and lead by example by dressing professionally.
- To ensure that all students are conforming to the School Policy.
- To have consistency in the implementation of the Uniform Policy.

3. *Parents*

- To adhere to the policy.
- To ensure their children are provided with the correct uniform including the P.E. uniform.
- To write a note explaining why their child is unable to wear the correct uniform for that day.

Note: Students not dressed in their correct uniform will not be allowed to participate in school outings/field trips.

Consequences of not wearing the school uniform:

- Step 1:** An oral warning given by staff member
- Step 2:** The class teacher or form tutor sends home a message to parents on Dojo or via email.
- Step 3:** Class teacher contacts parents by telephone and follows up with a message to parents on Dojo or via email to request the correct piece of uniform or shoes.
- Step 4:** Key Stage Coordinator calls the parents and send the child home to change.
- Step 5:** Meeting is called with SMT, Key Stage Coordinator, class teacher and parents.

Uniform Guidelines for N.B.A 2022 - 2025

It is our aim that students should develop a sense of pride in their work, behaviour and dress. Therefore, a high standard of personal appearance is expected of all students as they are ambassadors for Newton British Academy:

Jumper	N.B.A-Jumper.
Trousers	N.B.A-Navy, plain, smart, tailored (no denim or leggings)
Shorts (Primary/Tartan EYFS)	EYFS - NBA Tartan Shorts Primary - NBA Navy Shorts
Shirt Polo Tshirt(EYFS)	N.B.A White shirt (the top button should be fastened) All shirts must be neatly tucked in - this is mandatory.
School tie	N.B.A Traditional school tie (or scarf for female students in secondary)
Socks	Navy, black or white (no longer than knee length)
Footwear	Black shoes – no logos, boots, coloured or canvas shoes. NGS shoes for the relevant age group
Tights	Plain, white or black with no patterns
Skirt/Pinafore (EYFS)	N.B.A-All skirts should be worn at knee length as a minimum. Tartan pinafore EYFS
Outdoor coats/fleece	NBA jacket, plain navy fleece or jacket
Jewellery	Male students should not wear jewellery. Smart watches may not be worn. Female students may wear one small plain gold or silver stud earring per ear lobe. No other jewellery may be worn.

It is compulsory that all students are dressed in full school uniform every day. No coloured or canvas shoes are permitted. Shoes must be plain black with no logos or colours or students can purchase the NGS shoes for their age group. It is an expectation that both parents and students adhere strictly to the required dress code and ensure that students are neatly and dressed correctly at all times, white shirts tucked in. It is the responsibility of the parents to review the NBA's *Uniform Policy* on the school website and in documentation shared. Sixth Form students need to wear the NBA School uniform, this is standard practice at Newton Schools. Abayas can only be worn by Year 12 female students only in line with Higher Management direction.

Trips

Students not dressed in their correct uniform will not be allowed to participate in school activities or class trips. Parents will be contacted to bring in the correct uniform. Should the correct uniform not arrive before the class has left for their school or class trip, the student will remain at school with appropriate supervision. Where payment has been made for the trip, parents will not be reimbursed for the trip.

Students must come to school in their school PE kit on PE days. As the temperature drops in the winter months, the correct NBA jumper or hooded top is to be worn. Students will not be permitted to wear any other jackets not part of the school uniform.
