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All students attending Newton British School are required to wear the correct school uniform. There is no negotiation on this point. The Newton uniform is designed to be simple, distinctive and easy to obtain. It is primarily the responsibility of the class teacher to monitor compliance with the school uniform. However, all staff will ensure that students comply with the school's uniform policy. Students must adhere to these standards inside and outside school.

Rationale

- To promote group identity and equality among students.
- Promotes the Newton name outside of school
- To encourage respect amongst the staff and students.
- Students should wear their Newton uniform as a representation of their school pride

Objectives

- To ensure that the whole school is in the correct uniform.
- To inform parents of the correct way to wear the uniform.
- To develop a sense of belonging to a community.
- To help identify students on trips/outings.
- To encourage students to take pride in their appearance.
- To show Newton British School in a positive manner in the wider community.

Responsibilities

1. Students

- To ensure the uniform is worn correctly before entering and leaving the school.
- To look presentable throughout the school day.
- To wear the correct uniform during school excursions.
- To ensure that their uniform looks clean and tidy.

2. Staff

- To be positive role models and lead by example by dressing professionally.
- To ensure that all students are conforming to the School Uniform Policy.
- To have consistency in the implementation of the School Uniform Policy

3. Parents

- To adhere to the School Uniform Policy.
- To ensure their children are provided with the correct Newton uniform including the P.E. uniform.
- To inform teachers if their child is unable to wear the correct uniform on any day.

N.b. Students not dressed in their correct uniform will not be allowed to participate on school outings/field trips.

Consequences

- 1. A verbal warning given by staff member.
- 2. The class teacher sends a Dojo message home.
- 3. Class teacher contacts parents.
- 4. Key Stage Coordinator calls the parents and sends child home to change.
- 5. Meeting is called with SMT, Key Stage Coordinator, class teacher and parents.

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


Early Years Foundation Stage (KG 1 - 2)
